This week, pupils consolidated work on Decimals, completing a review in Maths. In English, they completed their STAR Reading test, worked on "Types of Nouns" exercises and wrote the introduction and first paragraph of their Instruction and Advice text.

Pupils completed and evaluated their Shaky Hand Tester project in DT. In PSHE, pupils discussed ways to support young people here and abroad to meet their aspirations. They also planned a sponsored charity event. Pupils used research to investigate how an individual or organisation has made a difference in campaigning against discrimination. They worked in groups to create a fact-file based on their research, which they presented to the class.



In Art, pupil used the Wax Resist technique to create vibrant pictures, reflecting a fairground theme.


