This week, pupils have continued their Instruction and advice text., writing a non-fiction piece on how to survive if stranded on an island. In Reading Comprehension, they explored the Retrieval Skill and in Grammar, they revisited the concept of "Articles".

In Maths, pupils were introduced to working with percentages. They established the relationship between fractions, decimals and percentages and completed exercises on these.


Pupils completed their first lesson on Spreadsheets in Computing. They have begun to use basic formulae correctly, and can recognise that writing formulae manually increases the chance of making errors.

To commence our Fairground project in DT, pupils researched the history of carousels.

In PSHE, pupils discussed peer pressure and the risks of smoking on the heart, lungs and liver.

In RE, pupils continued investigating how an individual or organisation has made a difference in campaigning against discrimination.

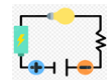
