During Science Week, Year 6 visited **Wakehurst** where they took part in outdoor science lessons called 'A Place to Grow'. Using scientific equipment, pupils measured wind speed and direction, recorded the temperature of the air and soil, and investigated vegetation cover to understand how plants grow in different environments.



Science Enrichment Day:

This week, year 6s took part in Science Enrichment Day where they completed the following Science activities: Inspired by the scientists, who established a correlation between the length of a shark and its age, children collected two data sets (ages and heights) and plot a scatter graph to see whether there is a relationship between height and age in humans. Using their graph, they investigated whether it is possible to predict the age of other children (and adults).



They conducted an experiment using a balloon to amplify sound. This helped them to recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium in the ear.



Girls also designed a futuristic item to solve a problem which developed their creativity and problem solving skills.
