raffle all go to benefit our pupils, so a big thank you to all those who took part.

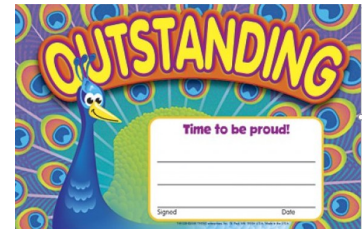


Well done to all the girls in Year 6 who attained 100% Attendance this term.
