# Winterbourne Junior Girls' Year 3 Newsletter

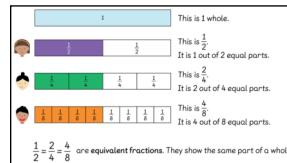


Week ending Friday 15th May 2026
