This week, pupils have planned and begun to write a balanced argument, using the term *peer pressure*, as depicted in our class novel "Thief". In reading Comprehension, pupils reviewed all skills learnt in a mini assessment and explored verb tenses in Grammar.

In Maths, pupils completed the unit on Area and Perimeter and have started exercises from the Volume unit.

In Computing they created an automatic scoreboard display using a micro:bit, and variables that update when an event happens.

During Geography, pupils designed a questionnaire and carried out an audit of the school grounds. They also compared their school grounds with that of another region.

Art was based on our Geography lesson, where pupils created mood maps to show their feelings about the school grounds.

Pupils have begun the Relationship unit in PSHE. They used characteristics and personal qualities to describe themselves and their peers.
