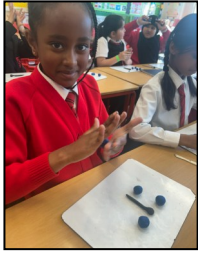

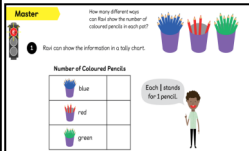
Water Safety Assembly:
