This week, pupils read with a focus on “inference”. They completed Grammar exercises on Adverbials. For Writing, they planned and wrote the first paragraph of a monologue from the character Tim’s perspective. In Maths, pupils converted between the measurements of length, mass and volume, as well as, between imperial and metric measurements. In Science, pupils tested the PH levels of soil samples from around the school. They discussed the importance of knowing the PH level levels for farmers. In Computing, they coded a micro:bit to measure temperature and produce different outputs based on this. Pupils described the different attitudes people have towards food and discussed how these can be affected by external influences during their PSHE session.



On Tuesday, pupils attended a showing of Disney’s Hercules at the Theatre Royal Drury Lane.
