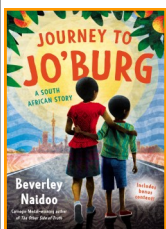

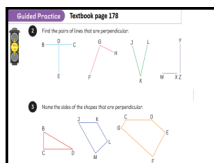


Week ending Friday 12th June 2026

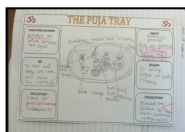

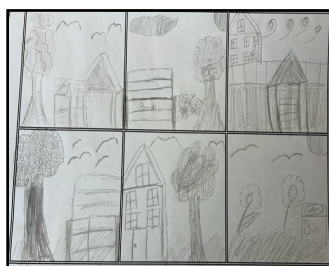
