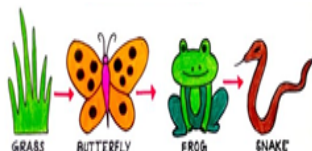
Year 5 Newsletter

This week, pupils have planned and begun writing a newspaper report based on an event in the class' novel "Thief". In Grammar they looked at how auxiliary verbs are used in sentences. In Reading Comprehension, pupils revisited a variety of reading skills. In Maths, pupils discussed roman numerals and completed calculations involving same.

In Science, the concept of Food Chains and Food Webs was explored. Pupils understand the terms, predator, prey, consumer and producer and the role each plays in the food chain.
