

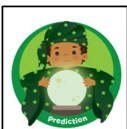


Winterbourne Junior Girls' Year 3 Newsletter



Week ending Friday 10th July 2026

English: This week, pupils worked hard to further strengthen their comprehension skills. They explored prediction using an extract from Stig of the Dump (Extract 2) and developed their retrieval skills through Norse Mythology by Neil Gaiman. The class demonstrated thoughtful reading and worked carefully to support their answers with evidence from the text.



Maths: This week, Year 3 have continued developing their understanding of perimeter. The children have measured the sides of shapes accurately using rulers and learnt how to use the properties of rectangles and squares to calculate perimeter more efficiently using multiplication. They have also explained their mathematical thinking by comparing different methods and justifying the most efficient strategy.

Geography: Year 3 completed their geography topic, 'How Can We Make Living Here Better for Everyone?' Pupils explored a range of national and global news articles, identifying key events and discussing their impact. They learned that a forecast is a prediction, or an informed guess, about the future, and used the information from the news to make their own forecasts.



RE: Pupils reflected on everything they had learned about how different religions and worldviews communicate with God or find meaning in life. By comparing Christianity, Islam, Judaism, Hinduism, Sikhism, Buddhism and Humanism, the children recognised that, although beliefs and practices may differ, all encourage kindness, respect and helping others. They demonstrated excellent religious literacy through thoughtful discussion and respectful comparisons of different faiths and worldviews.
