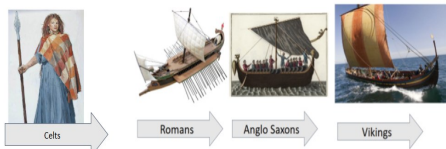


Aspirations, Expectations, No Excuses
