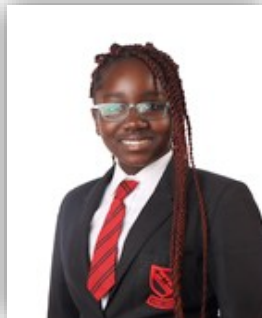
Week ending Friday 17th July 2026
